Q. Who Should Attend?

A. All girls ages 12 and older with an adult chaperone

Q. Can Mothers Attend the Conference with their Daughter(s)?

A. Yes, however, this conference is not designed as a Mother/Daughter event. This event is geared toward pre teen and teenage girls. Future plans are in the works to include session for family.

Q. What is Expected of Adult Female Chaperone?

A. Stay with your group or girl(s) throughout the conference

Q. How Many Girls Are You Anticipating?

A. We are anticipating well over 200 girls and adults

Q. Is there a Room Block for the Conference?

A. No, since this is a one day conference we did not feel the need for a group room block. We have worked out a discount rate with the doubletree Hotel for those who may need overnight accommodations. The rooms are based on first come, first basis so if you feel that you need a sleeping room please contact the GLLOP office ASAP at 214-457-3026. A credit card will be needed to reserve your room. Rates range from \$89-\$99 plus tax.

Q. Will we be able to Register Onsite?

A. Yes, but we highly recommend that you register online early so that we can prepare for your arrival. The hotel requires our final food guarantee 72 hours prior to the event and we want to ensure that you are counted in that final guarantee number.

Q. Is there a Charge for Parking At the Hotel?
